Acadia Residence Eco-Rep Job Description

Position: Volunteer Residence Eco-Rep

Departments: Residence Life/Acadia Sustainability Office

Supervisors: Grace Hamilton-Burge, ASU Sustainability Officer, Jodie Noiles, Acadia Sustainability Coordinator

Term: Sept – April

Role: The Eco-Rep serves as a resource on environmental sustainability for students living in residence at Acadia and as a liaison between those students and Residence Life, the ASU and the Acadia Sustainability office. Students in this position have an opportunity to make important contributions toward promoting environmental sustainability at Acadia. This voluntary position is open to any student living in residence. Elections are held in September.

Responsibilities:

- Educate students about environmental services at Acadia (e.g. waste and energy management).
- Assist with development and delivery of sustainability programs in residence in partnership with RA staff.
- Work collaboratively with other eco-reps to coordinate residence-wide sustainability programs (e.g. paper-towel free week).
- Work with the Acadia Sustainability Coordinator and ASU Sustainability Officer to organize outreach programs in residence.
- Monitor and manage *Call 2 Recycle* student battery recycling program in residence.
- Participate in campus sustainability week activities (end of October).
- Promote opportunities for extra-curricular involvement on campus (e.g. Acadia Farm) and in the community.
