

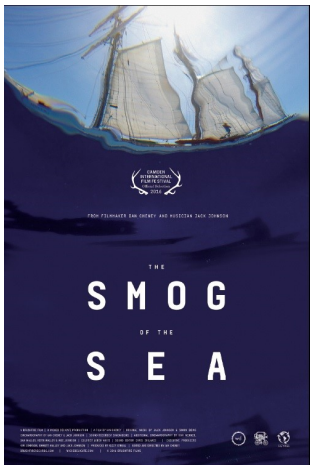
A Fine Kettle of Fish:

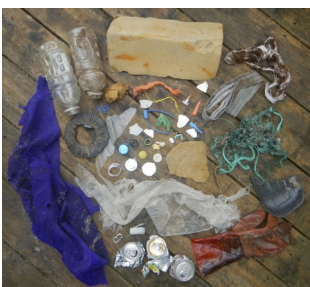
